Accreditation

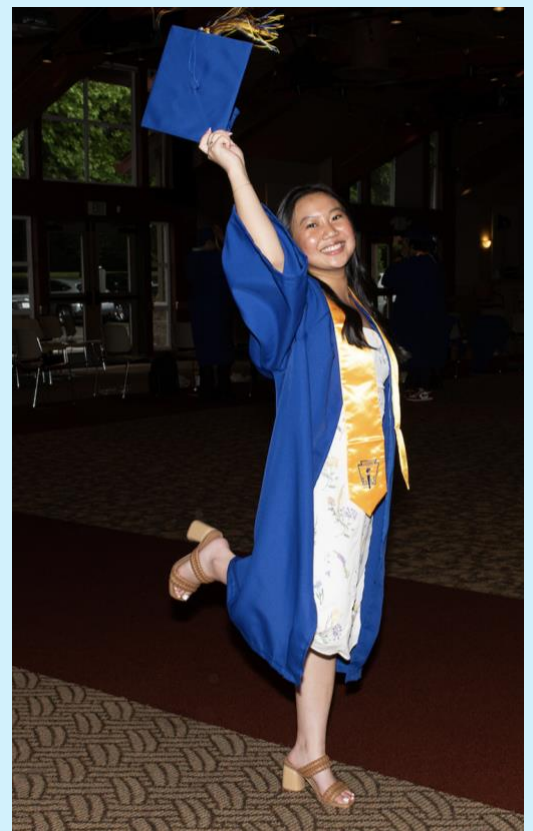

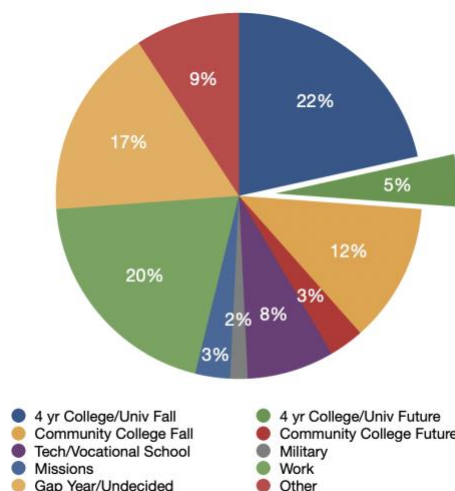
